NOTE: Teachers are eligible for the Sliffe Award if their school has participated in the AMC 8 for three consecutive years. Approximately fifty awards (five from each of ten USA regions) are given. The award includes \$100, a Sliffe pin, a certificate and a 1-Year membership in the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics. Selection is based on averaging the scores of the top three students in each participating school over a three year period. A Teacher may win this Award only once.
