

Faulkner Freshmen Art Scholarships

3 awards of \$200 each, applied to tuition.

Eligibility:

You must be a freshman in the Department of Art and Art History, a studio major, in your first year of study of art, working toward either a BFA or a BA in Studio Art.

You must have completed or are currently taking Visual Literacy I or II and one art history survey course, with no more than 21 credits of art and art history total, either completed or currently taken.

You must be enrolled full time in Fall 2009 semester (12 credits) in order to receive the award.

How to Apply:

Submit a portfolio of six 2D and/or 3D works of art to Richards Hall 120, on or before April 20. Label all work clearly. Flat work should be in a single portfolio. Attach the application form to the outside of the portfolio. Awards will be made based on the quality of the artwork as judged by the members of the Department of Art and Art History Scholarship Committee. Portfolios will available for pickup on April 24th from the Art Office.

Applicants will be notified by mail at their local address.
