

Special Student in Ceramics at UNL

This program brings in up to 3 students who have received their undergraduate degree and are looking for an intense ceramic experience in order to prepare for graduate school applications or other future goals.

Special students each receive a 10'x10' studio spaces within the undergraduate studio. They take one 3-credit course per semester and have critiques with the ceramics faculty and advanced undergraduates. They also have the opportunity to sit in on the graduate Colloquium class during spring semester.

Special students pay out-of-state tuition at the non-degree-grad student level, app. \$1850 per semester. They also pay a graduate student level lab fee of \$250. This covers all materials and firing. There is twenty-four hour studio access.
