

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INCOMING FRESHMEN

The UNL Department of Art and Art History will award 2 - 3 scholarships of \$1000 to incoming freshman students who **enroll as an art or art history major** in the Department of Art and Art History at UNL.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are available in art history and in studio art (including drawing, ceramics, graphic design, painting, photography, printmaking and sculpture).

All high school seniors who have applied to the University of Nebraska-Lincoln for the 2009-2010 academic year are eligible. Application procedures and deadlines as stipulated by the UNL Admissions office must be followed and are separate from this scholarship competition.

APPLICATION

The Scholarship Committee will make its decisions based on the following information the applicant must submit.

For your application to be considered, please send the following three items in one envelope to the address printed below. **Materials must be received in our office by March 1, 2009. No visual materials are required.**

1. Letter of application by the interested high school senior applicant.
2. Letter of recommendation from applicant's art teacher, counselor, OR another teacher.
3. Transcripts of applicant's grades.

RECIPIENTS

Scholarship awards will be credited toward the student's tuition and fees. Students who are selected must enroll as an art or art history major in the College of Fine and Performing Arts to receive an award.

Recipients will be notified by March 15, 2009. Acceptance of scholarship offer by incoming student must be made by April 1, 2009. Such a scholarship offer is contingent upon applicant's acceptance to the University.
