- * The Committee consists of GLBT and Ally students, staff, and faculty striving to create a campus environment supportive of GLBT people. We support the UNL non-discrimination policy and work to make it a reality.
- * Membership includes the Student Involvement Assistant Director for GLBTA Programs and Services, the Sexuality Education Coordinator for the University Health Center, and the Public Relations Chair for the Queer Student Alliance, as well as anyone who supports the Committee's mission.
- * The Committee has no supervisory powers over its members, but serves as a coordination and communication tool for its members.
- * The Committee provides support for its members as we participate in the slow and often painful struggle for social justice.
- * The Committee is an independent group that advocates for GLBT rights, meeting with the Chancellor annually to discuss the status of GLBT people at UNL.
- * The Committee raises funds to sponsor programs relevant to GLBT issues.
