

GSA Bill # 14 A bill restructuring GSA standing committees from seven back to six.

1	WHEREAS, the current bylaws description of the Professional Development Committee
2	includes maintaining a relationship with the University Office of Graduate Studies
3	Professional Development Team, which no longer exists; and,

WHEREAS, representatives are being encouraged to serve on external committees leaving fewer representatives available for internal committees; and,

WHEREAS, the committee for communications was recently formed to meet the dynamic needs of graduate students; and,

WHEREAS, there is enough overlap between the duties of the Professional Development Committee and two other GSA committee—the Social Events Committee and the Academic Affairs Committee—that it is reasonable for these two committees to take on the responsibilities of the Professional Development Committee.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, that the GSA supports folding the coordination and implementation of activities that promote the development of graduate and professional students, including but not limited to, networking activities, and guest lectures into the description of duties for the Social Events Committee and amending the relevant bylaws to reflect this change; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY ENACTED, that the GSA supports folding the management of the Special Projects Grants and career development workshops, into the description of duties for the Academic Affairs Committee and amending the relevant bylaws to reflect this change.
