Early May	Obtain Fulbright books from Office International Affairs, 420 University Terrace (17 <sup>th</sup> & R Street) and start your online application at <a href="http://www.iese.org/Fulbright/">www.iese.org/Fulbright/</a> . The online application opens on May 1.
Spring and Summer	Develop proposal and pursue inquiries and contacts abroad.
Late August	Contact Dr. Laura Damuth with any questions you have regarding your proposal, application or time line for applications.
September 9th	Deadline for application turned into UNL Fulbright Office.
October 14th	Deadline for submitting revised applications to Fulbright Office
Late January 2012	Expect notification of "recommended" candidates
March thru June 2012	Expect notification of Fulbright Grant
Fall 2012	Begin Your Fulbright !

## Overview of the Program

### Program Benefits

Financial support for one academic year  
Books and research allowance  
Round-trip transportation to host country  
Supplemental health and accident insurance  
Partial support for dependents ( a few countries)

### Eligibility

Have a Bachelor's degree before date of grant (i.e. mid-2012 but not a Ph.D  
(with some exceptions)  
U.S. Citizen (at time of application)  
No previous Student Fulbright grant  
Enrolled at, or recently graduated from UNL  
Prepared to do graduate work by mid-to-late 2012

### Application Procedures

Prepare a proposal of graduate study in a specific country (except for a few  
Teaching Assistantships)  
Obtain a statement of foreign language proficiency (except for English)  
Complete preliminary application by mid-September
