The Charlotte Kramer Foreign Study Scholarship was established by the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Alumni Association to assist students studying abroad.

Candidates for the award must meet the following requirements:

- I. Enrolled at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln as a full-time student in the academic semester immediately preceding the term for which the scholarship is awarded.
- II. Obtained sophomore class standing by the beginning of the term for which the scholarship is awarded.
- III. Possess a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 or above.
- IV. Enrolled in a foreign study program sponsored by or approved for credit by University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
- V. Deadline is March 1 with scholarship to be used the following summer or academic year.

This scholarship is awarded without regard to financial need nor race, color, religion, age, sex, national origin or disability. The scholarship is awarded for one academic term only and may not be renewed.
