- 150 \$1500 scholarships will be awarded.

- Current résumé (including student activities, honors or awards, leadership positions, etc.).
- Official transcript.

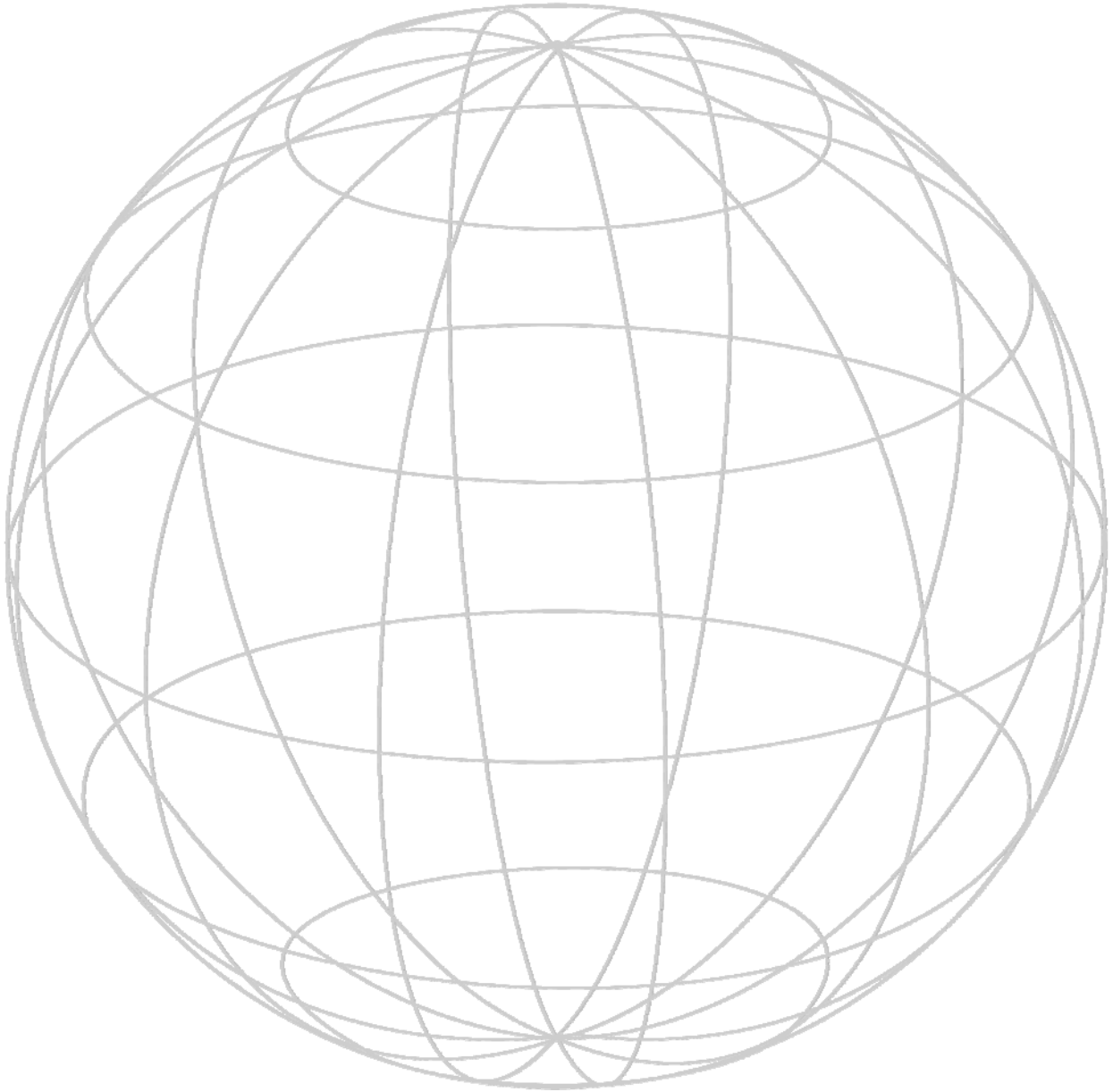
