

Study Abroad Photo Contest

The purpose of this contest is to recognize individuals who have taken exceptional photographs while on Study Abroad programs. The goal is to use these photographs to publicize the importance of UNL Study Abroad programs. A \$50 prize in the form of a University scholarship will be awarded to the winner. Other awards may also be given. Entries may be displayed on the International Affairs' website. Winners will be notified after judging takes place and scores are calculated.

Contest Rules

Deadline for entries is October 15, 2006.

1. All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form;
2. Entries should be submitted in electronic format (CD). Black and white and/or color photographs are acceptable;
3. All entries must be photographs taken by study abroad participants while on a study abroad program and must be the work of the person submitting the photo;
4. No more than 10 photographs may be submitted per entrant. Multiple photos can be submitted with a single entry form;
5. Entries will be evaluated on appeal, content and representation of the study abroad experience. Decisions are final.

CDs will become the property of International Affairs. International Affairs reserves the right to incorporate submitted photos into marketing campaigns and potential future publications that encourage and promote Study Abroad.
