SUBJECT: **Hy-Vee Scholarship Program**

Hy-Vee believes in cultivating the future. Since 1969, Hy-Vee has awarded up to \$80,000 in scholarships to eligible students. Each scholarship is for \$1,000 and goes to high school seniors and college students. Enclosed please find information to post in your school for any interested eligible students.

COLLEGE ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

Qualified students are eligible to apply every year. A student may pursue any course of study but it must lead to a four-year college degree.

Students are eligible for consideration if:

- The student was employed at a Hy-Vee or subsidiary location (office, distribution, retail) after June 1 of the year preceding the award of the scholarship (for example, employment as of June 1, 2009, for scholarships awarded in the year 2010.) The student does not need to be currently working.
- The student is classified as a full-time freshman, sophomore or junior during the time of the application process. The student must be classified as a full-time sophomore, junior or senior at the time funds are disbursed.

Students will need to submit by the February 10 deadline:

- A completed application form.
- Personal statement about future goals and why you should receive the scholarship. The judges attach significant weight to this statement.
- Summary of activities.
- Official transcript (with registrar's seal), which should include present student status (for example, junior second semester), last semester's GPA and cumulative GPA.
- Personal reference letter from a professor, Hy-Vee store director or supervisor.
