Building-wide Behavior/Discipline  
Implementation Plan

The committee wishes to evaluate and possibly revamp the high school's current discipline system. A wider array of consequences for disruptive behavior and rewards for positive behavior is needed. The High School is looking into a plan developed by Dr. Dixon of Junction City, Kansas. The plan involves significant changes to the current discipline system including implementation of an "after-school school" in lieu of out-of-school suspension, and changes to the building's in-school suspension program. The Discipline Committee and the SRS team will combine to facilitate the implementation of this plan.

Jason Sutter, Asst. Principal, will coordinate this plan.

Schedule:

May 2000: Team visit to Junction City, Kansas

June 2000: Student Handbook changed to reflect new programs

July 2000: Joint team meeting for planning implementation, writing guidelines and developing materials

August 2000: Introduction of additions/changes to the student handbook. Communication of program guidelines and uses to staff. Implementation of Beatrice After School Education (BASE) and the new and improved In-School-Suspension program.

September 2000: Evaluation methods developed

December 2000: Evaluation of program, plan for continuation.

Cost: Estimated \$480
