

## Instructional Technology Advisory Committee

The *Instructional Technology Advisory Committee* is charged to assist the Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs (SVCAA) in identifying and resolving issues concerning the assessment, acquisition, use, configuration and support of campus-wide instructional technology resources.

Specifically, the UNL *Instructional Technology Advisory Committee* will make recommendations to the SVCAA on planning and policy matters pertaining to the assessment, implementation, configuration, enhancement and use of campus-wide instructional technology and corresponding support considerations. The Senior Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs will bring these recommendations to the Academic Deans and the Chancellor's Senior Administrative Team for incorporation into campus-wide planning strategies and funding proposals for the design and on going support of these technologies. Annually, the Senior Vice Chancellor will brief the Academic Planning Committee on the work of the Instructional Technology Advisory Committee.

The Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and the Vice Chancellor for the Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources shall appoint the members of the *Instructional Technology Advisory Committee*. Membership will include representation from the Academic Colleges and University Libraries, appointed by the deans; two representatives from the Teaching Council, one faculty member and one student; Information Services; Extended Education and Outreach; and Nebraska Educational Telecommunications. Permanent members include the Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs; the Associate Vice Chancellor for Information Services; the Associate Vice Chancellor for Extended Education and Outreach; and the Director of Nebraska Educational Telecommunications. The Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs will chair the committee.
