The proposed new campus-wide general education program is outcomes-based. Year 3 of the Initiative for Teaching and Learning Excellence calls for outcomes-based program assessment projects that use direct measures of student learning to guide decisions about improving curriculum and pedagogy. What are student learning outcomes? What is an outcomes-based assessment measure?

This campus presentation is designed to answer those questions and provide faculty with help drafting program-specific student learning outcomes. In addition, Dr. Lee will offer advice on developing appropriate assessment measures for determining the ways in which students are or are not achieving those outcomes. The final part of the session will include time for interaction and questions.

This session is intended to help faculty prepare strong proposals for ITLE-3 and better understand the proposed new campus-wide general education program.
