

Chancellor's Policy Memorandum 2004-01

**Establishment of the
Enrollment Management Council**

The Enrollment Management Council is hereby established. The purpose of the Council is to provide an integrated, university-wide coordination of efforts to manage enrollment and to enhance recruitment and retention of students.

The Council shall be co-chaired by the Dean of Undergraduate Studies and the Dean of Admissions. The membership, in addition to the co-chairs, shall consist of:

1. Associate Deans appointed by each of the undergraduate colleges and the University Libraries
2. Director of University Communications
3. Director of Institutional Research
4. Director of Extended Education
5. Director of Scholarships and Financial Aid
6. Director of Registration and Records
7. Director of Student Involvement
8. Director of University Housing, and
9. A representative from the Chancellor's Office

The Chancellor may from time to time appoint other individuals to sit with the Council.

The Council shall develop and periodically review a plan for managing the undergraduate enrollment of the campus and shall make recommendations to enhance the recruitment and retention of undergraduate students. The Council shall, from time to time, invite the Chancellor to participate in its meetings.
