2.1 Update on COVID Efforts

Kolbe provided a brief update on campus COVID testing and the Executive Committee discussed faculty concerns regarding students not complying with the mask mandate.

4.1 Executive Committee Goals

4.2 Syllabus Policy Revisions

Herstein reported that the committee working on revising the Syllabus Policy has suggested some revisions to the existing Senate Syllabus Policy. Eklund noted that the revisions are a good effort to counteract the extreme syllabus bloat that is occurring in some colleges. A fillable syllabus template that faculty could use to assist them in developing their syllabus for their courses was also created. The Executive Committee reviewed and edited the suggested revisions. Buan moved to present the Syllabus Policy to the Faculty Senate at the September 7th meeting for consideration and voting would occur at the October 5th meeting.

5.0 New Business

5.1 Statement on Sexual Assault/Harassment

The Executive Committee discussed whether to endorse a statement from members of the Campus-wide Collaborative on Sexual Misconduct regarding the recent rapes on campus and the need for the University to redouble its efforts to make the campus a safe

environment for all. The Executive Committee agreed that the Collaborative's statement should be stronger and discussed how the Committee could distribute the statement if it decides to endorse it. Minter stated that she would contact the faculty who wrote the statement and share the Committee's concerns.
