



GSA Bill #20

A bill allocating funding to the Career Fair

1 **WHEREAS**, graduate students are a unique population of students at the University of  
2 Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL) comprising 20% of the student population; and,  
3  
4 **WHEREAS**, the graduate student assembly (GSA) is committed to helping graduate students  
5 find employment after graduation; and,  
6  
7 **WHEREAS**, the existing Career Center at UNL does not provide a career fair oriented  
8 specifically toward graduate students; and,  
9  
10 **WHEREAS**, the career fair planning committee would like to use the GSA and Association of  
11 Students of the University of Nebraska (ASUN) logo on advertising and fair associated handouts.  
12  
13 **THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED**, that GSA endorses the 2018 Career Fair and grants the use  
14 of its logo on webpages, handouts, and flyers associated with the fair;  
15  
16 **THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that GSA will support the collaborative career  
17 fair by using GSA's communication platforms to encourage all graduate students to attend the  
18 event;  
19  
20 **THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that GSA will allocate up to \$900 from the  
21 Committee for Professional Development's budget line 403 for support of a morning networking  
22 event the day of the STEM career fair (February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017) specifically for graduate students to  
23 engage with businesses attending the Career Fair and for advertising and printed materials;

25 **THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, that GSA will reserve a booth at each of the  
26 three career fairs (February 13, 14, 15) to provide maps to graduate students that indicate which  
27 businesses hire graduate students and to advertise GSA and ASUN;
