Aiah Nour was one of eight UNL undergraduate students to receive a 2021 Luminary Award during a ceremony at the Champions Club in April. Sponsored by the Office of Student Affairs, the annual awards are designed to shine a light on students who make a difference through their leadership and community engagement, while excelling in their academic pursuits. Aiah was honored for her leadership and involvement in the Black Student Union, African Student Association, ASUN Student Government, the Innocents Society, and her commitment to research through the McNair Scholars Program.





Clarice Santos participated in the Minority Health Disparities Initiative Undergraduate Research Program during Spring and Summer 2021. She worked on her project, *Mediators of Violence Exposure and Substance Use (MoVES)*, under the guidance of Dr. Trey Andrews, Department of Psychology and Latinx Mental Health and Treatment Outcomes Lab.

During the 2021 Undergraduate Sociology Awards, Clarice won the Vanetta Aaron Student Paper Competition Award for Best Paper on Race, Class, or Gender for her McNair Summer Research paper, Unsterile Needle Acquisition Among PWIDs in Rural Puerto Rico: A Comparison Between Those in and out of Treatment.

Stephanie Perez was selected to participate in the virtual 2021 Brown University Summer Research Early Identification Program (SR-EIP). Stephanie conducted research on the remediation and behavior of environmental contaminants groundwater and soil, with Dr. Kurt Pennell, professor in the Chemical and Environmental Engineering Department at Brown University. Since the UNL McNair Scholars Program began in 1995, we've served 320 students. Excluding the continuing Scholars, 97 percent have earned their bachelor's degree, 150 UNL McNair Program alumni have earned master's degrees, 22 have earned professional degrees, and 53 UNL McNair Program alumni have achieved a Ph.D. Currently, 25 UNL McNair alumni are enrolled in Ph.D. programs, 15 are pursuing master's, and 3 are pursuing professional degrees.
