## **Software License Agreement**

- 1. LANDYNE software is not sold; rather, copies of the software are licensed to you.
- 2. You may freely download and distribute the LANDYNE software, which can be used in demo mode for evaluation.
- 3. Licenses can be purchased from LANDYNE. A price list will be provided on request. A validated license specifies the computer media (i.e., hard drive and flush drive) you run the software on.
- 4. When you request the software license, you agree to pay the license fee.
- 5. Once LANDYNE receives the payment, we will prepare the license files and sent to you within five days.
- 6. The software will continuously improve; only major upgrades will be marked as a version change. You need to pay only the price difference when you want to upgrade from the previous version to the new version.
- 7. You agree to give a proper reference to Landyne (https://landyne.com) when you use the software in your research work for publication.

## **Term of Service**
